DELAWARE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SEEKS APPLICATIONS FOR THE DKMM SOLID WASTE DISTRICT POLICY COMMITTEE

The Delaware County Board of Commissioners is seeking to nominate one (1) Delaware County resident for appointment as a citizen representative to the Delaware-Knox-Marion-Morrow Solid Waste Management District Policy Committee. Appointment to the Committee will be the decision of the full DKMM Board of Directors, which is composed of the commissioners from the four counties represented in the District. The individual appointed will serve a two (2) year term from the date of appointment.

The Policy Committee creates, reviews and updates the Solid Waste Plan that facilitates the DKMM District's ability to meet Ohio Environmental Protection Agency guidelines for handling solid waste. The Committee meets two to three times per year and is currently engaged in writing the District's new Five-Year Plan.
