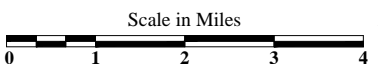
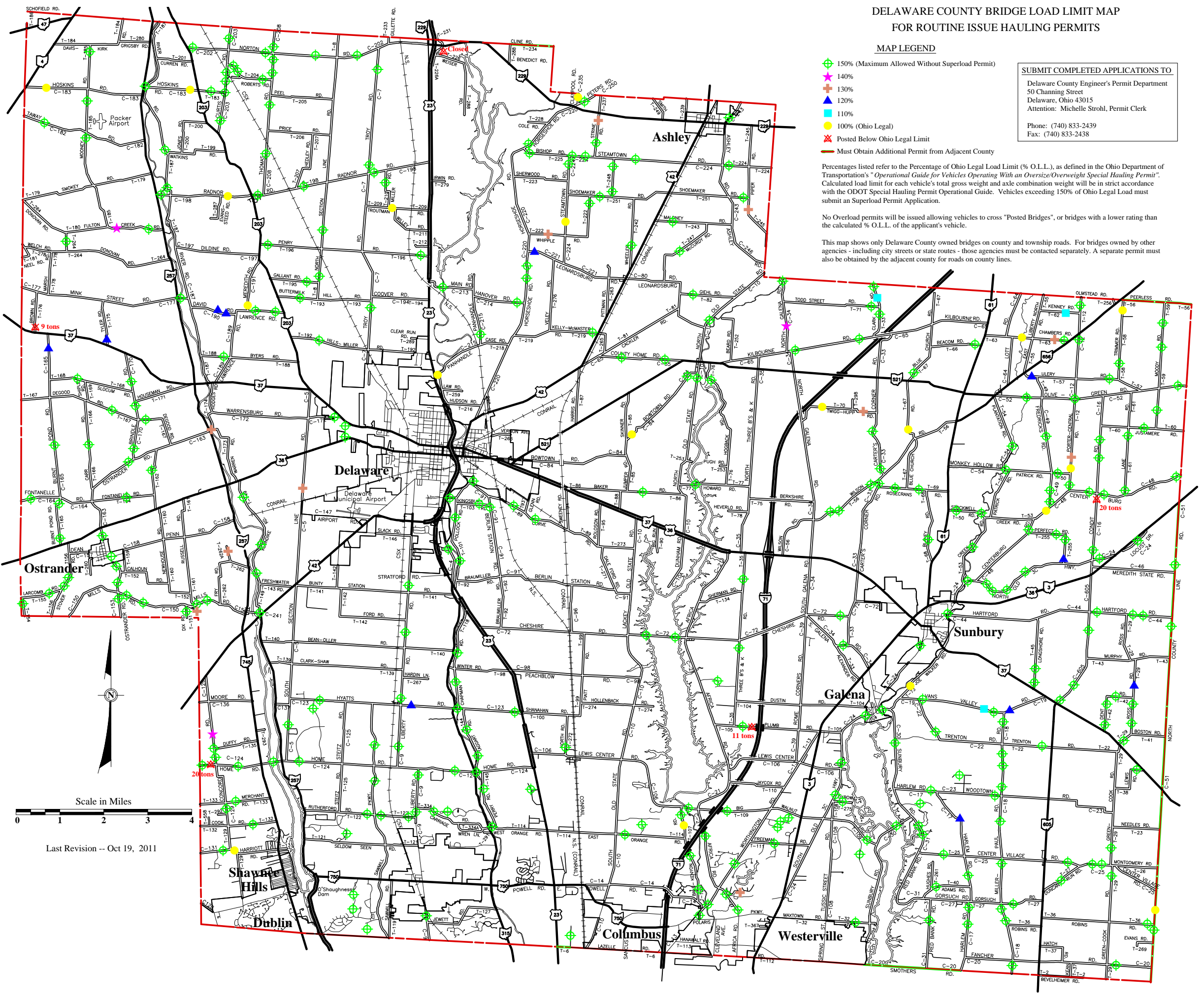

Percentages listed refer to the Percentage of Ohio Legal Load Limit (% O.L.L.), as defined in the Ohio Department of Transportation's "Operational Guide for Vehicles Operating With an Oversize/Overweight Special Hauling Permit". Calculated load limit for each vehicle's total gross weight and axle combination weight will be in strict accordance with the ODOT Special Hauling Permit Operational Guide. Vehicles exceeding 150% of Ohio Legal Load must submit a Superload Permit Application.

No Overload permits will be issued allowing vehicles to cross "Posted Bridges", or bridges with a lower rating than the calculated % O.L.L. of the applicant's vehicle.

This map shows only Delaware County owned bridges on county and township roads. For bridges owned by other agencies - including city streets or state routes - those agencies must be contacted separately. A separate permit must also be obtained by the adjacent county for roads on county lines.
