**RESOLUTION 94-336**

**IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING USER RATE FEES FOR THE DELAWARE COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT IN CONFORMITY WITH PROVISIONS OF SECTION 6117.02 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND COUNTY RATE RESOLUTION:**

It was moved by Mr. Sheets, and seconded by Mr. Parrott, to adopt the following Resolution of Necessity to amend the Delaware County Sanitary Sewer Rate as previously amended in Resolution of the Delaware County Sewer District.

**IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHING AND AMENDING CHARGES FOR THE SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM AND SANITARY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT:**

**SYSTEM CAPACITY CHARGES**

	<b>TYPE OF USE</b>	<b>NEW CHARGES</b>
**	Residence	\$5,900.00
*	Business	\$5,900.00

\* Per Equivalent Residential Unit: Equivalent residential units to be determined by the Delaware County Sanitary Engineer on the basis of 290 g.p.d. maximum residential usage (2.9 persons/house x 100 g.p.d. per person).


\*\* Homes in existence and connected to a home unit or commercial unit disposal system prior to the initiation of operation of the facilities within the service area of the facilities shall be allowed to have system capacity charges prorated over a ten (10) year period and shall pay the financing charges on said charge at the rate of County Financing of the debt service, providing, that said connection is accomplished within ninety (90) days of notification. The capacity charge for all other uses shall be paid in full, prior to connection the sanitary sewer.

New Residential Subdivisions which connect to the Central Sewer System shall pay fifty percent (50%) of the Capacity Fee for each platted lot in the Subdivision prior to platting.

The new Capacity Charges shall go into effect immediately for new Subdivisions. For existing Subdivisions (Signed Subdivider's Agreement) the new fee shall go into effect June 17, 1994. The Capacity Charges associated with the Powell Assessment Project shall remain at \$2,400.00 per residential equivalent.
