Delaware County—Benton to be Sworn in as Delaware County Commissioner

Jeffrey T. Benton will be sworn in as Delaware County Commissioner on Tuesday, September 8, at 9 am, in the Commissioners Hearing Room. Judge David Hejmanowski, Delaware County Juvenile/Probate Court, will perform the Administration of the Oath, with Benton's family, friends, and supporters present.
