DELAWARE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SEEKING APPLICATIONS FOR THE BERKSHIRE LANDING NEW COMMUNITY AUTHORITY

The Delaware County Board of Commissioners is seeking to appoint one (1) citizen member to the Berkshire Landing New Community Authority Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees consists of seven (7) members. This Board shall appoint three (3) citizen members to represent the interests of present and future residents of the District and one (1) member to serve as a representative of local government. The three appointed citizen members and local government member shall each serve a two (2) year term. ***At this time, the Board of County Commissioners is seeking to appoint one citizen member for a term commencing Feb. 5, 2017 and ending Feb. 4, 2019.***

The Board of Trustees of the Authority is the governing body of the Authority and is responsible for taking official actions to implement the development program for the New Community District, including the financing and acquisition of property and community facilities, the levying and collection of community development charges, and the facilitation of orderly development within the District.
