Delaware County—Stapleton Elected Second Vice President of County Commissioners' Association of Ohio

Delaware County Commissioner Dennis Stapleton was elected by his peers to serve as 2nd Vice President of the County Commissioners' Association of Ohio (CCAO). The election was held this week at the association's annual meeting in Columbus. Commissioner Stapleton will move to the position of 1st Vice President in 2014 and will then serve as President in 2015.

Since his election as Delaware County Commissioner, Stapleton has served on the CCAO General Government and Operations Committee; the Jobs, Economic Development and Infrastructure Committee; the Taxation and Finance Committee; the Ohio Council of County Officials; and the CCAO Deferred Compensation Committee.

"I look forward to helping the leadership of this statewide organization impact the issues confronting all 88 counties across the state, while still assuring the needs of Delaware County are met. We are also very excited about hosting our national organization, the National Association of Counties (NACo), in 2017, and we will spend the next few years preparing for that event," shared Commissioner Stapleton.

Prior to his election as a Commissioner in 2010, Stapleton served in four General Assemblies in the Ohio House of Representatives for the 88th District.
