Delaware—Today in session, the Delaware County Commissioners approved the hiring of David Dombrosky as the new Director of the Delaware County Department of Job and Family Services. David has most recently served as the Director of the Clark County Department of Job and Family Services in Springfield, Ohio, a position he has held since November 2013.

While at Clark County JFS, he was responsible for developing and implementing vision-supporting strategies to improve staff and partner accountability, as well as a performance management system for both the staff and the providers. He managed 225 full-time staff and oversaw an annual budget of approximately \$40 million. Prior to Springfield, he served as the Deputy Director over Administrative Services with the Cuyahoga County Division of Children and Family Services, managing 105 employees. Cuyahoga County Division of Children and Family Services employs 800 staff with an annual operating budget of \$147 million.

"David brings proven experience as a collaborative leader with evidence-based accountability methods and an outstanding performance management track record. His wide breadth of experience with the diversified client base in both Springfield and Cleveland provides an excellent preparation for the future growth of our Job and Family Services Department," said Dawn Huston, Assistant County Administrator.

David received his Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Bowling Green State University and his Master of Arts degree in Criminal Justice from The State University of New York at Albany. He will begin with JFS on Monday, August 10.
