Delaware County—State Job and Family Services Director hired by County Commissioners to head up County Agency

The Delaware County Commissioners appointed Shancie Jenkins as the new Director of Delaware County Job and Family Services late yesterday in their reconvened session. Ms. Jenkins is the Senior Policy Advisor to the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and has been with that organization since 2009. Prior to the Ohio JFS position, she served as the Research, Evaluation, & Planning (REP) Supervisor for the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services.

"Ms. Jenkins has worked in senior management and executive positions within Job and Family Services at both the State and local levels and brings extensive knowledge of Job and Family Services programs. We are pleased to have her joining our directors," shared Commission President Dennis Stapleton.

Ms. Jenkins graduated from Kent State University with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration and Ohio Dominican University with a Master's Degree in Business Administration. She will begin her new position on January 30.

As Director of the Delaware County JFS, Ms. Jenkins will be responsible for directing the operations of all departments within JFS and overseeing all activities, including personnel, program compliance and budgeting. The Delaware County Department of Job & Family Services offers programs and resources to help people attain self-sufficiency, enhance employment opportunities and live in safe, stable families. She will be a member of the management team of directors reporting to the Board of Commissioners.
