DELAWARE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SEEKING APPLICATIONS FOR THE NORTHSTAR NEW COMMUNITY AUTHORITY

The Delaware County Board of Commissioners is seeking to appoint two members to the NorthStar New Community Authority. The Board of Trustees of the Authority shall be composed of seven (7) members. This Board shall appoint three (3) citizen members of the Board of Trustees to represent the interests of present and future residents of the District and one (1) member to serve as a representative of local government. ***The Board of County Commissioners is currently seeking to appoint two (2) citizen members to serve two-year terms commencing August 16, 2016 and ending Aug. 15, 2018.***

The Authority facilitates the financing and construction of specific infrastructure improvements benefiting property owners within the Authority's boundaries. In addition, the Board of Trustees would have primary responsibility to oversee the financing of the infrastructure and improvements described above and to provide for the levy and collection of the community development charge within the Authority.
