DELAWARE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SEEKS APPLICATIONS FOR THE DELAWARE COUNTY RURAL ZONING COMMISSION

The Delaware County Board of Commissioners is currently seeking to appoint one regular member and two alternate members to the Rural Zoning Commission. This Commission consists of five (5) regular members who each serve a five (5) year term and the two alternates also serving five (5) year terms. The Rural Zoning Commission forms a cohesive, diversified group. Members shall be residents of the unincorporated area of the county included in the zoned area (Marlboro, Radnor and Thompson Townships). The term for the regular member will begin Jan. 1, 2017 and expire on Dec. 31, 2021; one alternate term will expire on Dec. 31, 2019, and one alternate term will expire on Dec. 31, 2021.

As a Rural Zoning Commission member, your contribution is vital to the development and future endeavors of Delaware County. This Commission works in conjunction with the zoning inspector and other local agents to ensure that policies and practices are being adhered to and enforced. Specific responsibilities of the Rural Zoning Commission are:

- Preparation of the zoning resolution, both text and map(s);
- Initiation of amendments to zoning text and map(s);
- Make formal recommendations on all amendments.
